

Lee Kunyong

Born 1942 in Sariwon, North Korea Lives and works in Seoul, South Korea

이 건용

이건용은 한국 아방가르드 미술의 선구자로, 1960년대 후반부터 **'Space and Time 미술학회(ST 그룹)'**와 **'Avant-Garde (AG 그룹)'**을 이끌며 전위적이고 실험적인 미술 운동을 주도했다. 그는 **'예술이란 무엇인가?'**라는 근본적인 질문을 출발점으로 삼아 신체와 공간의 관계를 지속적으로 탐구해 왔다.

그의 작업은 단순한 회화적 표현을 넘어 퍼포먼스, 비디오, 조각, 설치 등 다양한 매체를 활용하여, 예술이 존재하는 본질적 의미를 찾고자 한다. 그는 신체를 독립적인 조형 요소이자 가장 직접적인 예술 매체로 사용하며, 전시 공간과 관람객 사이에서 작품이 어떻게 관계를 형성하는지를 실험한다.

특히 '드로잉의 방법(Method of Drawing)' 시리즈에서는 신체의 물리적 움직임과 회화적 결과물을 연결하며, 캔버스를 등지고 서서 그리거나, 캔버스 옆에서 팔만을 움직여 하트 형태의 구조를 만들어낸다. 이러한 작업들은 의도적인 조형 행위가 아니라, 신체의 궤적을 그대로 남긴 흔적이라는 점에서 독특하다. 그는 전통적인 회화의 개념을 벗어나신체 자체가 예술이 되는 방법을 제시하며, 퍼포먼스적 행위를 통해 삶과 예술의 경계를 허무는 실험을 지속하고 있다.

그의 퍼포먼스적 제스처는 대부분 사진, 비디오, 혹은 기억을 통해 기록되며, 이는 기존 전시 공간의 개념을 확장하는 시도로 이어진다. 그는 가장 일상적인 행위 속에서도 예술이 존재할 수 있음을 강조하며, 이를 통해 전통적인 예술 형식과 개념을 재해석한다.

Lee Kun-Yong

Lee Kun-Yong is a pioneer of Korean avant-garde art, having led the 'Space and Time Art Society (ST Group)' and the 'Avant-Garde (AG Group)' since the late 1960s, spearheading experimental and progressive artistic movements. He has continuously explored the relationship between the body and space, starting from the fundamental question: "What is art?"

His work goes beyond mere pictorial expression, incorporating various media such as performance, video, sculpture, and installation to seek the essential meaning of art's existence. He uses the body as an autonomous sculptural element and the most direct artistic medium, experimenting with how his work interacts with the exhibition space and the audience.

In particular, his 'Method of Drawing' series connects physical movement with pictorial outcomes, as he draws while standing with his back to the canvas or moving his arms beside it to create heart-shaped structures. These works are not intentional compositions but rather traces of bodily movement, making them unique in their approach. By transcending traditional painting, he presents a method where the body itself becomes art, continuously experimenting with blurring the boundaries between life and art through performative actions.

His performative gestures are often documented through photography, video, or memory, leading to an expanded concept of exhibition space. He emphasizes that art exists even in the most ordinary activities, reinterpreting conventional artistic forms and concepts through his work.
